Kia ora koutou,

As you will have heard last night the Prime Minister announced there will be no change to current alert levels for the next 12 days. Auckland will remain at Alert Level 3 until 11.59pm 26 August. Therefore, there will be no change on Monday to what we did on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday during Level 3 last week.

Cabinet will review this decision on Friday 21 August and formally consider alert Levels on Monday 24 August.

Children of parents who are deemed essential and do not have an adult to care for them at home may be supervised at school. We have been in contact with most of these families already and some children have been attending in school bubbles. Distance learning for all students is up and running and we have given out many school devices to students requiring them.

Keep connecting with your child's teacher and please read all information sent through the school so you can be kept fully informed. Teachers working from home during the week during normal school hours to connect with you and provide distance learning for your child.

Please note that Teacher Only Day, scheduled for 21 August has been postponed. This is now likely to be in Term 4 and I will confirm the date once I have met with the Board of Trustees.

This is an unsettling time again for you and your family. Remember we are only a phone call or a click away should you need assistance.
